REPORT OF THE SUB-COMMITTEE FOR MEMBERSHIP September 03,2002

A. <u>UPDATING REGISTER OF MEMBERS</u>

- 1. As at September 02, 2002, 782 names were entered in the New Members Register. Of this number, 12 members are deceased and their names will be added to the list of Deceased Members in the next issue of the Members Directory.
- 2. Out of the balance 770 current members, the addresses/present whereabouts of 170 members are not available. Their names will be given in the aforesaid Directory separately. 84 names transferred from the Old Members Register to the New Register are included in the 170 names. Therefore the OBA is in touch with 600 Members.
- 3. B. <u>MEMBERSHIP CARDS</u>
